The city is a matter of negotiation – and everyone is a part of it – if conscious, by coincidence, active, passive, angry, content, adapted, by itself, for or against all the others.

Currently we are encountering a huge public interest for the city. The participation, enforcement, making and positioning of individual interests are notably increasing. New spaces are arising, getting lost, being struggled over and left, knitted and posted on, discussed and overdiscussed. Individual and public interests are nowhere as close to each other as in the city. The meaning and power of the private interest often gets uncovered in the decline of compromise. Claiming the city for yourself and your equals leads to hard negotiations, keen separations, fights and alliances in a lot of spaces. The negotiation of claims and requirements is inevitably challenged to prevail within the limits of private and public interest.

From the toad to the highway and from the spokes-person to the urban initiative

What power does the individual have in the urban system?
Who motivates, who drifts along, who halts and who turns around?
Who is right and who has The Right to the City?
Where are collisions and what is negotiated where?
What is not-in-my-backyard-attitude and what is legitimised protest?
How is a city for all generated from a sum of egos?

The new urban spacemag issue is dedicated to "egourbanism" and stories, pictures and activities that include all while taking the ego as a measure.
